As part of our next topic, we will be studying The Gunpowder Plot, Bonfire Night and Fireworks. For homework, we would like you to reflect upon the story of Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot and complete at **least two** (you can do more!) of the following tasks:

1. Write some questions that you would have liked to ask Guy Fawkes during the Gunpowder Plot. Include some illustrations!
2. Draw a colourful fireworks scene and write some adjectives around the fireworks to describe the sight, smell and sounds, for example 'bright' and 'loud'.
3. Write some instructions about 'How To Keep Safe on Bonfire Night'. Remember to use sequencing connectives such as: First, Then, Next, After that and Finally. Remember to add some colourful pictures to support your writing.
4. Draw a portrait of Guy Fawkes and write three interesting facts about his life.
